- Identify knowledge of the implemented curriculum changes.
- Demonstrate their current use and integration of technology across the curriculum,
- Discuss innovative teaching practices, and
- Articulate proposed involvement in the school community through co-curricular or extra-curricular interests.

Candidates must be eligible for, or hold current Queensland Teacher Registration, submit to an Anglican Diocese National Register check, and should hold a current first aid certificate which includes CPR.
