Candidates are invited to discuss how they develop key foundational skills and build mathematical confidence in students that supports student achievement and academic outcomes.

Additionally, we are very interested in hearing from candidates who are keen to be involved in school life outside of the classroom and could contribute or participate in our extensive co-curricular offerings.

Candidate applications should:

- Detail recent senior Mathematics teaching experience across all levels and specifically including Specialist Mathematics.
- Demonstrate their current use and integration of technology across the curriculum,
- Discuss innovative and interactive teaching practices, and
- Share areas of potential involvement in the school community through co-curricular or extra-curricular interests.

All staff at The Southport School should be supportive of the Code of Conduct and stated values and Christian Ethos of the School, must be eligible for, or hold current Queensland Teacher Registration, submit to an Anglican Diocese National Register check, and must hold a current first-aid certificate. Candidates must be able to provide a recent Criminal History Check certificate.
